Info about the monument: The *Farm Worker Monument Project* is unique as there are no other such monuments dedicated to generally honoring farm workers and their many contributions to our communities. The project includes two life-size bronze statues (a man and a woman) set within a plaza setting. The total project is projected to cost \$350,000 and about half of this amount has been raised. As part of the fundraising effort, there is the opportunity for individuals who've been, or are currently, farm workers to have their names inscribed on the monument for \$100. Farm workers who can't afford this amount will be able to submit their names for a lesser donation.

Performing at the benefit are Conjunto Familia Moraza, Grupo Yolipan, and the Folklorico Mestizo de Oxnard College. \$10/person donation suggested.

The Gallery's art reception will honor the artwork of *Manuel Unzueta*. Since the late 1960s Manuel Unzueta, a prolific artist, has created many fascinating series of artworks and exhibitions, which have been warmly embraced by the public. Since his early drawings of tormented figures influenced by Mexican muralist Jose Clemente Orozco, his Chicano murals expressed that tendency and, his more colorful work of the late 1970s, and his recent cultural concern, Unzueta has grown in exposure and maturity.

Unzueta's exhibition, entitled *Diamantina*, will show between March 2 - April 11. The opening art reception will take place on Friday, March 7 from 6-9pm. All are welcome to meet the artist in addition to enjoying live Jarocho music by the Familia Moraza. Refreshments will be provided.
