Musicians are invited to bring your instruments and join me for an impromptu jam session in the Gazebo Park. If it turns out to be a warm day, you can cool off with some cold ice pops from our popular push cart vendors.

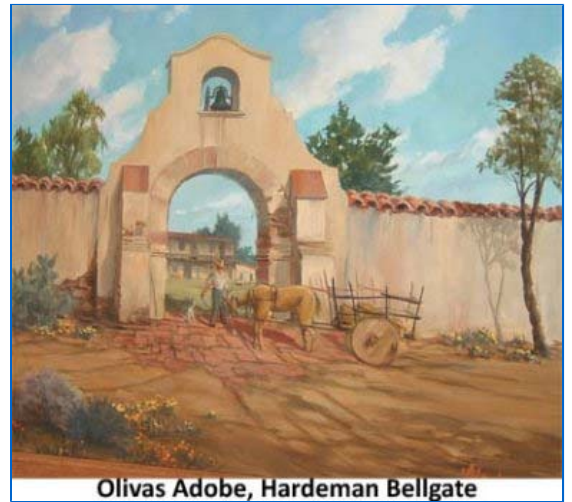
